



George R. Pond and Cesare Sabelli attempted a "Non-Stop" Transatlantic Flight to Rome, Italy 1933 from New York that, due to the crash in Ireland and subsequent repairs, didn't arrive in Rome until June 11, 1934

The Four Covers we have listed on our price list and web site are new to the market. They were discovered several years ago among a remainder part of the Estate of John A. Klemann, Nassau Stamp Co., active 1849-1941. They were among the largest stamp dealers in the US in the 1900's-1930's and handled many important properties including the "Earl of Crawford" U.S. collection, Grinnell Hawaii Missionaries, and countless others. He was famous for his lowball offer of the C3a airmail invert sheet and owned the discovery sheet of C3 grounded planes. This flight is best described in the 1998 Irish Crash Airmail Catalogue by Ronny Vogt whose numbering system we use.
